RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

For Recycling pickup the Town is divided into two sections (**RED** and **BLUE**).

Your regular trash will be picked up on Wednesdays only unless otherwise noted on calendar.

Please separate trash from recyclables by at least six (6) feet (opposite ends of the driveway if possible).

Trash and Recycling must be placed curbside no later than 7:00AM.

Extra Trash **STICKERS** are \$5.00 and sold by Allied Waste for any trash bags that will not allow your Toter lid to close.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD Collected on your recycling day	Heavy cardboard, usually brown, with ridged layer sandwiched between two flat sheets. Chipboard (i.e. Cereal boxes, etc.)	MUST BE FLATTENED NO LONGER THAN 3ft. x 3ft. will not accept in a box	Waxed cardboard, frozen food boxes, milk or juice boxes. Broken down boxes placed in a box will not be picked up. Paper or commingled recycling with cardboard with not be picked up.

LEAVES, BRANCHES & SHRUBS Collected on a 5 day schedule in different sections of Town – Leave curbside if you get missed call Allied Waste 1-800-442-9006	OCT: 11th - NOV: 25th APR: 23rd - MAY: 28th Leaves, Branches & Small Shrubs shall be placed in paper bags or separate trash barrels and CAN be in same container or tie branches/shrubs into bundles. Branches shall be no more than 3 ft. in length and 4 inches in diameter.
